

GOLF HOUSE RULES

PRO SHOP

- No golf clubs to be left in locker room
 - Storage facilities available (\$1 pw)
- Locker facilities available (\$1 pw)

CLUB HOUSE

- No golf clubs to be brought into club house (includes foyer)
 - Storage facilities available downstairs
- No golf clubs, buggies or carts to be left out the front of the club
 - Buggies and clubs may be left in the loading dock area outside kitchen or in storage facilities downstairs
 - Motorised carts may be left downstairs
- Cart Trailers to be parked in area near villas or on street adjacent to 16th fairway
 - No parking on Acacia St adjacent to car park or in bus bays

JUNIORS RULES

PRO SHOP

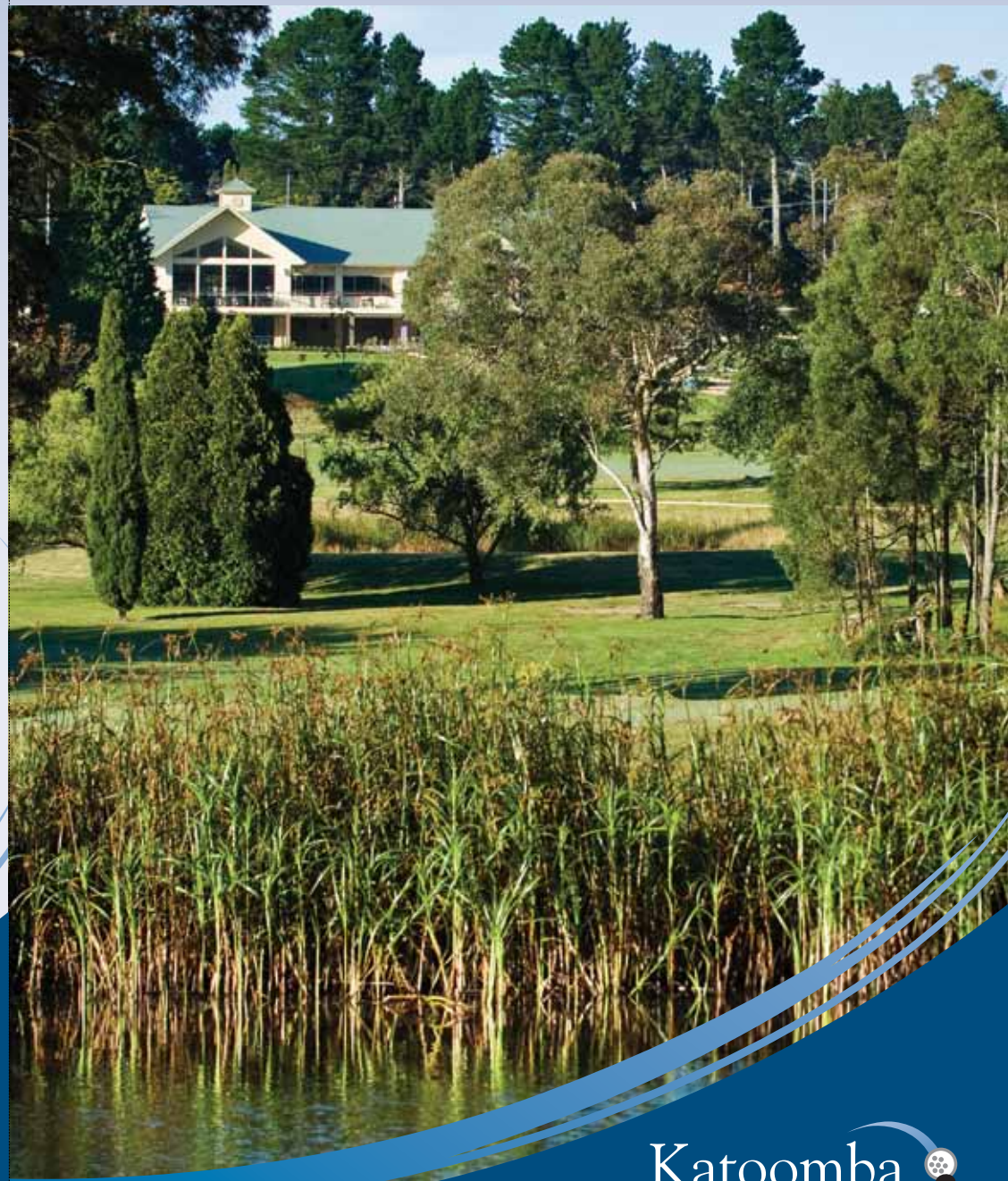
- No loitering in pro shop
- Only enter pro shop to buy something, book in for comps or lessons/clinics

GOLF COURSE

- As per golf etiquette

CLUB HOUSE

- No entry in to club house unless accompanied by a parent or guardian
- Must not be within 2 metres of bar at any time
- Minors (U 18) cannot be served at bar
- Food orders must be done through pro shop or by parent/guardian

CLUB POLICIES

ALCOHOL

- All alcohol consumed on Club premises (including the course) must be purchased from the Club.
 - Drinks cart operates every Saturday plus special events
 - Beers are now available for sale in the Pro Shop
 - Pricing is in line with the bar
 - Soft drinks and water are available at all times
- All policies and rules in regards to the responsible service of alcohol (RSA) must be adhered to
- Proof of age as per RSA may be required

DRESS RULES (GOLF COURSE)

- Neat and tidy attire required at all times

ACCEPTABLE

- Collared shirts
- Golf or polo shirts
- Modest logos
- Dress shorts
- Trousers
- Slacks
- Socks must be worn
- Enclosed shoes (flat soled)
- Runners and sports shoes (flat soled)
- Soft spikes only

UNACCEPTABLE

- T Shirts
- Sleeveless shirts
- Strapless tops
- Tank tops
- Football jumpers
- Tracksuit pants
- Football or other sports type shorts
- Work boots
- Ripple soled shoes
- Thongs and sandals
- Footwear not deemed as acceptable

GOLF COURSE ETIQUETTE

PRIOR TO PLAY

- Arrive at least fifteen minutes early to check-in at the Pro Shop.
- If you cannot meet your tee-time booking please contact the Pro Shop to cancel.
- Subject to other cancellations, you may be asked to change playing groups.
- Collect a sand bucket from areas adjacent to the 1st tee.
- Be ready to play when it is your time to tee off.

ON THE TEE

- Be ready to tee off when it is your turn (glove on, ball ready etc).
- Mark your ball so that you can identify it.
- Hit ONLY when golfers ahead of you are out of range.
- Stand still and facing other golfers while they are hitting.
- Watch where all balls go to avoid time spent looking for lost balls.
- Yell the warning "FORE!" if your ball is heading toward another golfer.
- Sand your divot.

THE FAIRWAY

- Walk directly to your ball unless you reach someone else's ball first.
- Place your bag or cart near you when hitting.
- Take no more than one practice swing.
- Player furthest from the hole usually plays first, but golfers out of range of the group in front can play first, if ready.
- Sand your divot, and others you may see whilst walking the fairways.
- Walk briskly between shots and be ready to play when it is your turn.
- Keep pace with the group in front of you at all times.
- Assist playing partners when needed by bringing clubs, finding lost balls, etc.
- Adhere to motorised cart rules at all times.
- Rake bunker after playing shot.

ON THE GREEN

- Place your bag or cart between the green and the next tee where possible.
- Take all clubs that you may need.
- Repair your own ball marks and others.
- Avoid stepping on another player's putting line.
- Players begin putting when all balls are on the green.
- The person furthest away from the hole putts first.
- On long putts, have another player attend the flagstick.
- Mark your ball if it is in the path of another player's ball.
- Record all scores on the next tee (not on the green).

LANGUAGE

- Do not shout or use loud unseemly language
- No offensive language
